Alabama.



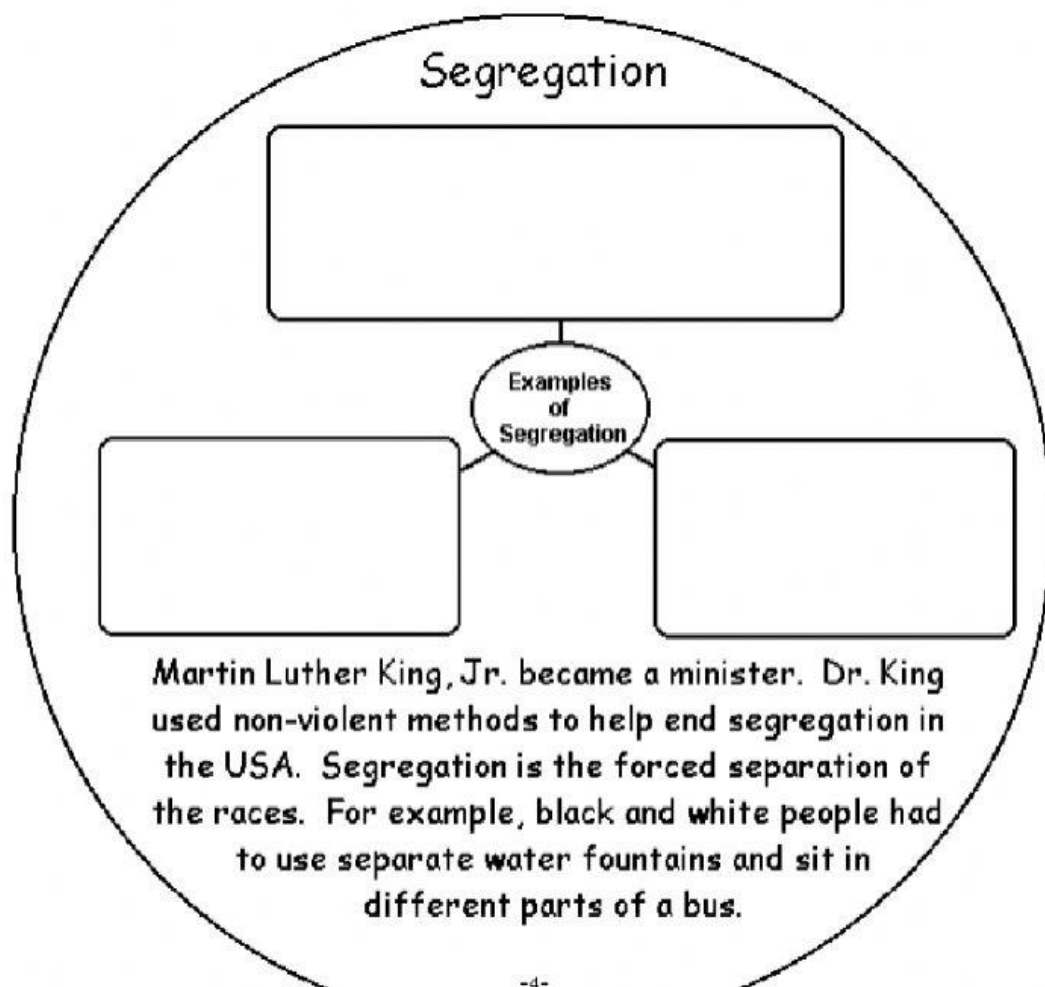

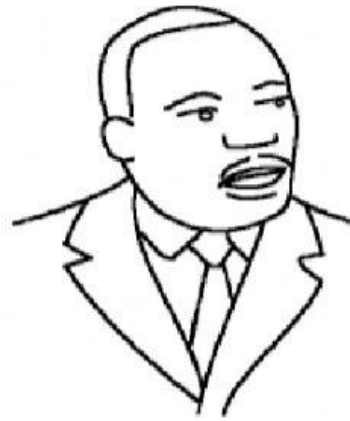

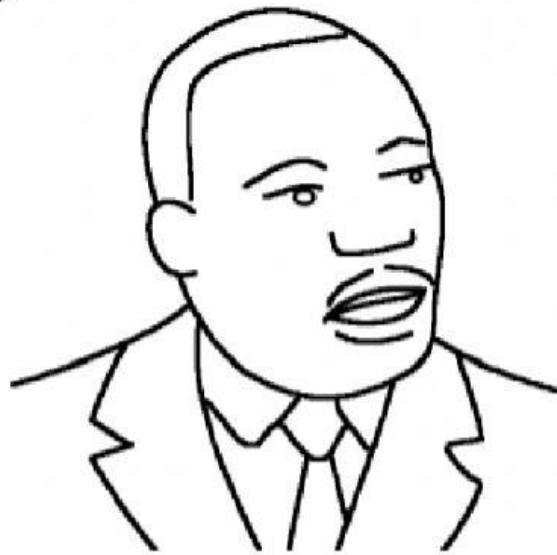
