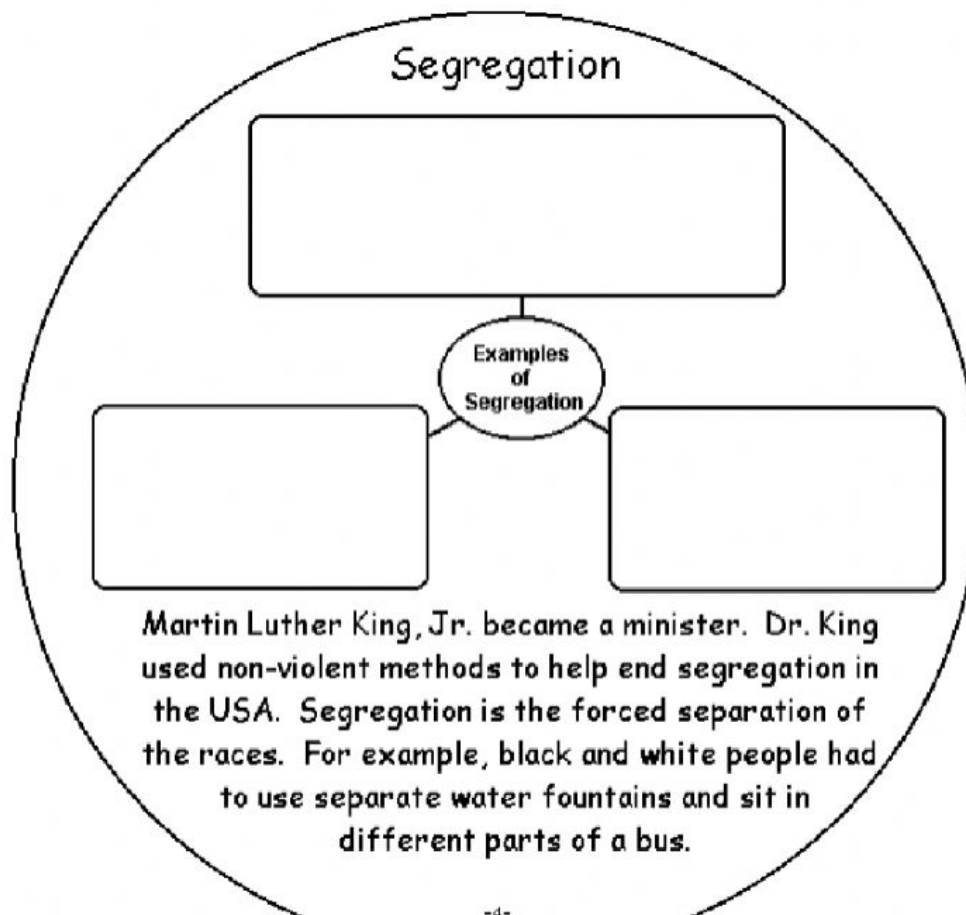
Color Alabama (AL) red

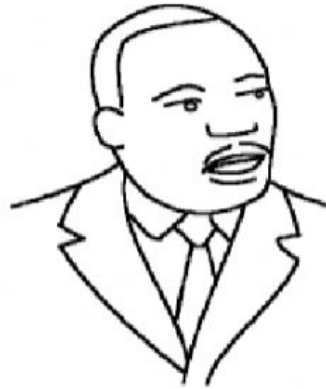

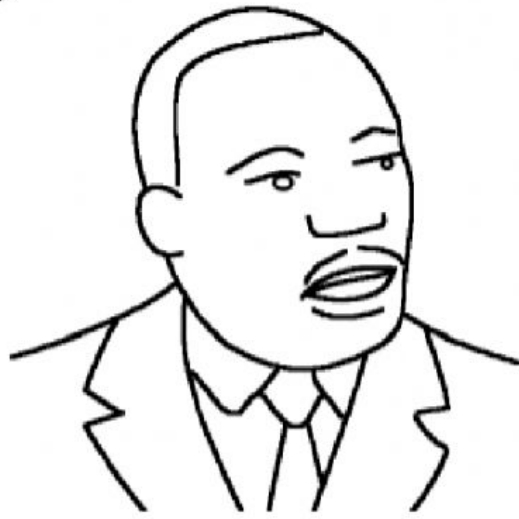
