

Simple Past vs Present Perfect



PAST SIMPLE-wiadomo kiedy, podane kiedy (we know "when")

PRESENT PERFECT-niepodane kiedy, nieważne kiedy, związek przeszłości z terażniejszością, użyte są charakterystyczne słówka np. already, just, ever (no information when exactly)

CHOOSE **SIMPLE PAST** or **PRESENT PERFECT**

1. I **HAD / HAVE HAD** my job for two years and I like it. (HAVE)
2. **DID YOU GO / HAVE YOU GONE** to Lublin last summer? (YOU/GO)
3. She **LIVED / HAS LIVED** in Radom for three years now. (LIVE)
4. **DID YOU EVER BE/ WERE YOU EVER/HAVE YOU EVER BEEN** to Busko-Zdrój? (YOU/EVER/BE)
5. I **PLAYED / HAVE PLAYED** tennis yesterday. (PLAY)
6. Tomek **BROKE / HAS BROKEN** his leg last year. (BREAK)
7. How long **WAS DAREK /HAS DAREK BEEN** interested in cinema? (DAREK/BE)
8. They **WENT / HAVE GONE** to Wuhan in 2019;. (GO)
9. She **PLAYED / HAS PLAYED** tennis last Sunday. (NOT/PLAY)
10. **DID YOU GO / HAVE YOU GONE** to the cinema last night? (YOU/GO)
11. **DID SHE / HAS SHE WORKED** in Zagnańsk? (SHE/WORK)
12. We **WENT / HAVE GONE** to Cedzyna last summer. (GO)
13. She **JUST TIDIED / HAS JUST TIDIED** her room. (JUST/TIDY)
14. We **DIDN'T EAT / HAVEN'T EATEN** yet. (NOT/EAT)
15. Baśka **STUDIED / HAS STUDIED** German when she was a young girl. (STUDY)
