**FUTURE CONTINUOUS TENSE : will be + Ving**

**HEAD OUT:** Go out, leave a place

**FIND OUT:** Discover some information.

**WORK OUT:** End in a good way.

**COME OUT:** To become known, to come into public view, to debut

**PHASE OUT:** Remove gradually
