

Compound words with ‘some’ and ‘any’

some (somewhere, something, someone, ...) → used in positive sentences	any (anywhere, anything, anybody, ...) → used in questions and negative sentences.
I'm buying something nice for my friend.	Did you find anything interesting? I can't see Sarah anywhere .
My workbook must be here . (<i>Mein Workbook muss hier irgendwo sein.</i>)	Does one know where the station is? (<i>Weiß irgendjemand, wo der Bahnhof ist?</i>)
Let me get you thing to eat. (<i>Lass mich dir etwas zu essen holen.</i>)	There isn't thing we can do here. (<i>Wir können hier nichts tun.</i>)
Here is one who wants to talk to you. (<i>Hier ist jemand, der mit dir reden möchte.</i>)	Is Big Ben where near here? (<i>Ist Big Ben hier irgendwo in der Nähe?</i>)

Compound words with ‘every’ and ‘no’

every (everywhere, everything, everyone, ...) You can hear the sound of Big Ben everywhere in central London. Everyone in our class has to stay at home.	no (nowhere, nothing, nobody, ...) Nowhere else do you find so many interesting sights. There is nobody in the classroom.
I think one likes ice cream. (<i>Ich denke, alle mögen Eis.</i>)	This road leads where . (<i>Diese Straße führt nirgendwo hin.</i>)
thing in the Tower of London is very old . (<i>Alles im Londoner Tower ist sehr alt.</i>)	body knows where the girls are. (<i>Niemand weiß, wo die Mädchen sind.</i>)
body likes to be a winner. (<i>Jeder gewinnt gern.</i>)	There is thing to eat in the fridge. (<i>Im Kühlschrank ist nichts mehr zu essen.</i>)
