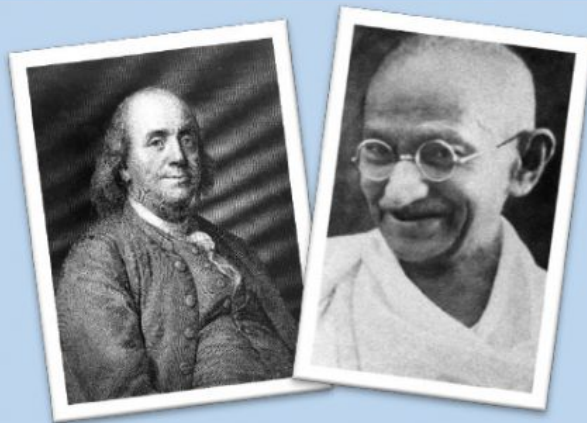


Who was?
