Past perfect simple

We use the past perfect

- to talk about something that had already happened before a certain time in the past.

Everyone had gone to bed by 11 p.m.

By early afternoon I had finished the book.

- to talk about something that had already happened before something else happened in the past. We use the past perfect to talk about what happened first, and the simple past about what happened after it.

The train had already left (= this action happened first) when we arrived at the station.

(= this happened after the first action)

Time expressions

by	<i>By 11 a.m. they had drunk four cups of tea each.</i>
already	<i>Sandra had already done the shopping when I called her.</i>
after	<i>Ian phoned after you had left.</i>
before	<i>We had driven twenty miles before we saw a petrol station.</i>
just	<i>I had just finished my homework when Matt phoned.</i>
ever / never	<i>They had never seen such a beautiful sunset in their lives.</i>
