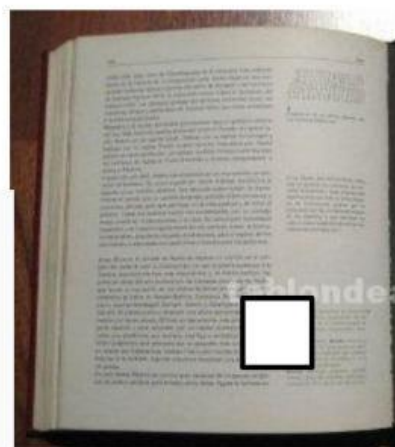
1) **Table of contents:** the list of chapters and the page son which they start.

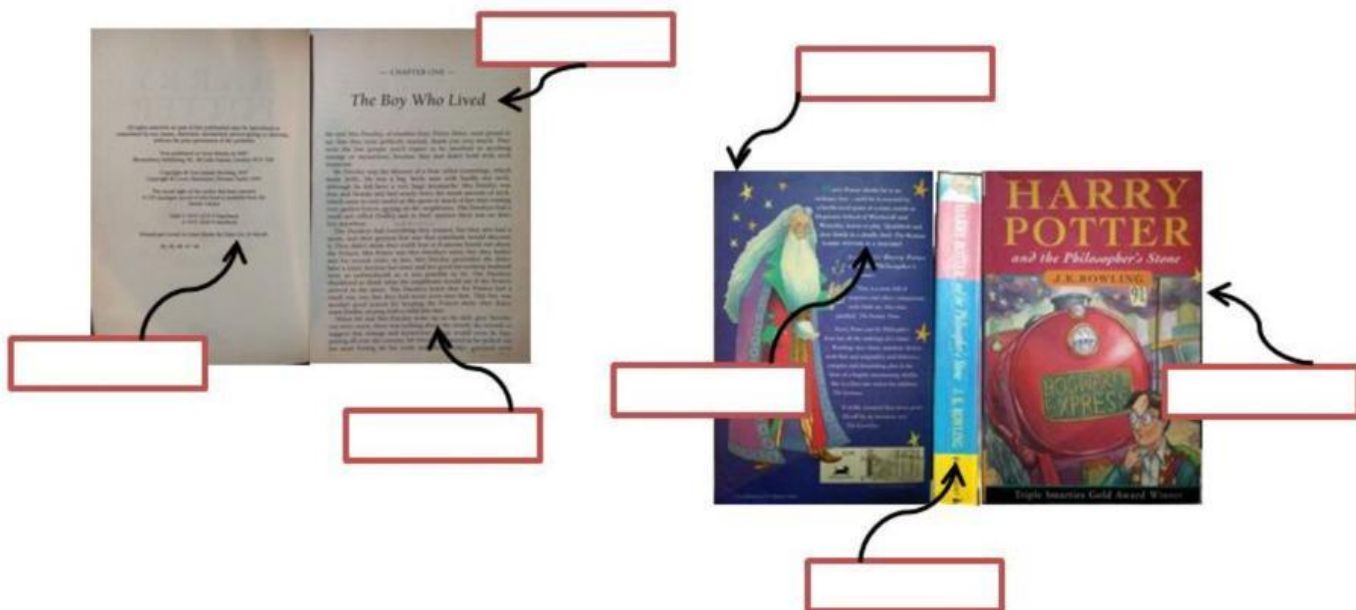
