


Farming

Farming: the practice of cultivating the land or raising stock


The Bahamas has three important natural resources in large quantities. Natural resources are things of value provided by nature. Our country has:

- 260,000km² of sea, this gives us rich fishing grounds.




Farming

Not many people farm for a living anymore, but farming remains the most important occupation in the world.





Livestock Farming

Livestock farming is the raising of animals for **their products** or their **meat**. Some livestock is: **Poultry** are raised for their meat or their eggs. Poultry farms are in New Providence and Grand Bahama. Some of the poultry we eat come from America.




Cattle or beef includes cows, sheep, goats, and pigs. Pigs are raised for their meat. They are raised in New Providence. **Beef cattle** are found on North Andros and New Providence. Beef cattle are raised for their meat.

Today, there are fewer dairy cattle, so most all of our milk, butter, cheese, and yogurt are imported from other countries.



Field crops

Field crops include corn, Irish potatoes, cassava, sweet potato, yam, and pigeon peas. Vegetables include cabbage, okra, eggplant, hot peppers, carrots, plantain, and onions. There are also salad vegetables such as cucumber, tomatoes, sweet pepper, and beets. Fruits are sour oranges, oranges, grapefruits, limes, lemons, tangerines, watermelons, and cantaloupes.
