FARMING IS THE MOST IMPORTANT OCCUPATION!

Farming is the practice of cultivating the land or raising stock.

The Bahamas has **3 natural resources** in large quantities.

Natural resources are things of value provided by nature.

1. Our country has large, flat islands that can be used for farming
2. Year-round sunshine, which means we can grow tropical fruits and vegetables
3. 260 000km squared of sea, this gives us rich fishing grounds.

Farming was once the chief way of life in nearly every country. People cannot live without food, and nearly all food comes from crops and animals raised on farms.

Livestock farming is the raising of animals for their products or for their meat. **Poultry** are raised, for example, for eggs and chicken meat. **Cattle** are raised for milk or beef. **Pigs, goats and sheep** are raised mainly for their meat and sometimes their hides and wool. Poultry farms can be found in New Providence and North Andros. Today, there are fewer dairy cattle, so most of our milk, butter, cheese and yogurt are imported from other countries

Field Crops

Other products grown in our country include field crops like vegetables and citrus fruits which are fruits not grown on trees but vines.

Example of Field Crops

Irish potatoes, cassava, sweet potatoes, yam pigeon peas.

Vegetables: cabbage, okra, eggplant, hot peppers carrots plantain, and onions

Salad Vegetables: cucumber, tomatoes, sweet pepper (bell peppers), and beets.

Fruits: sour oranges, oranges, grapefruits, limes, lemons, tangerine, watermelons and cantaloupes
