

- 1 The Great Gatsby was directed by Baz Luhrmann and is based on a novel by F. Scott Fitzgerald. Starring Tobey Maguire and Leonardo DiCaprio, the film is surprisingly positive in places, but it is a sad story about love and destiny of human. It was originally released in 2013, however now it is a modern classic.
- 2 The film is set in the 20s in the USA. Nick Caraway (Tobey Maguire) arrives in 1922 New York in search of the American dream. Nick, a writer, lives next to millionaire Jay Gatsby (Leonardo DiCaprio) and across the bay from his cousin Daisy (Carey Mulligan) and her husband, Tom (Joel Edgerton). Nick finds himself in the world of the rich, the world of impossible love, dreams, and tragedy.
- 3 Luhrmann makes few changes to Fitzgerald's original novel. The ending is even more exciting than the book. Lana Del Rey's song «Young and Beautiful» creates an exciting atmosphere throughout the film.
