I. What Biography is?

The word "BIOGRAPHY" comes from medieval greek

BIOS: LIFE

GRAPHIA: WRITING

BIOGRAPHY is a detailed description or account of a person's life. Biography is life story of a person written by someone else. It is non fiction text. Usually biographies are about historical figures, but sometimes they are also about people still living.

2. Characteristics of Biography

- It is not written by the subject.
- It is always written in third person.
- It is based on research, not on imagination
- It describes the person's surroundings (where, when and how the person lived).

- Shows how the person affected other people's lives through their behavior, discoveries, social reform, etc.
- Supplies details that illustrate the person's individuality.
- Use vivid language to narrate events.



TYPES AND FUNCTION BIOGRAPHY

SHORT AND LONG BIOGRAPHY

- *short biography* Focuses only on highlights of a person's life
- *long biography* Talks about life and times of someone in a lot more detail.

THE FUNCTION OF BIOGRAPHY

- *To know a person's story about his/her life outside of any accomplishments this person may be known for.*
- *To give much information easily and educate the readers.*



Generic Structure

Biography is categorized as recount text, So the generic structures are :

1. Orientation

It gives the readers the background information of the person. It is the opening paragraph. It usually contains newsworthy information about the person.

2. Series of events

Activities which done chronologically from the beginning to the end.

3. Reorientation

It consists of a conclusion or comment, of the writer. Sometimes it tells about the achievements or the contribution of the person.

Language Features



Use of simple past tense to express the past activities



Sometime, use other past tenses, such as past perfect tense, past continues, past perfect, etc.



Focus on temporal sequence. it is used to set the events chronologically. e.g : First, Next, then, after that... Finally



Focus on specific participants. biography will refer to someone worklife.



Use of action verbs. it can be V1, V2, and V3

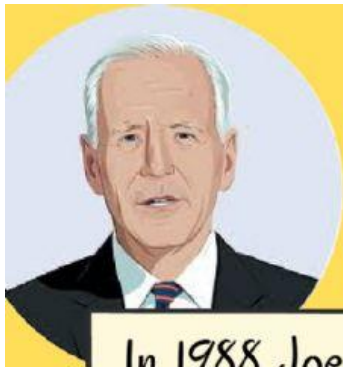
