4. The office has 112 stacks of paper. They order 224 more stacks of paper. How many stacks of paper will they have in all?
5. The car lot had 334 new cars. 212 cars were sold. How many cars are left?
6. My aunt baked 557 cupcakes. She, also, baked 132 pies. How many cupcakes and pies did she bake altogether?
