## COMPARATIVES

### Short Adjectives

We add **-er** to the end of short adjectives to make comparative.

| Short adjectives ...                                  | Spelling rules                   | Examples                                                                     |
|-------------------------------------------------------|----------------------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Usually                                               | + <b>er</b>                      | slow → <b>slower</b><br>fast → <b>faster</b><br>tall → <b>taller</b>         |
| Ending in -e                                          | + <b>r</b>                       | large → <b>larger</b><br>nice → <b>nicer</b>                                 |
| Some two-syllable adjectives, especially ending in -y | -y → -i<br>+ <b>er</b>           | hungry → <b>hungrier</b><br>happy → <b>happier</b><br>funny → <b>funnier</b> |
| Ending in a vowel + a consonant                       | double the consonant + <b>er</b> | big → <b>bigger</b><br>fat → <b>fatter</b><br>fit → <b>fitter</b>            |

Example:

Bart is **taller than** Maggie.



### Long Adjectives

We add **more** in front of long adjectives to make comparative.

more + adj. (2 or more syllables) + than

Example:

beautiful → **more beautiful than**  
Maggie is **more beautiful than** Mr. Burns.



## PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE

\*to talk about events happening **NOW**



I **am studying** English



She **is driving** a car



They **are having** dinner



What **are you doing?**

I **am cooking**

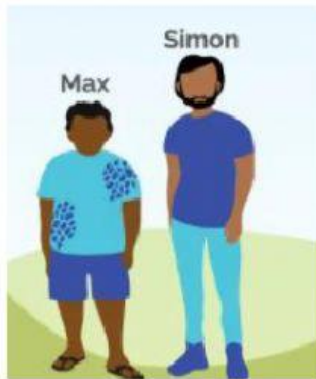

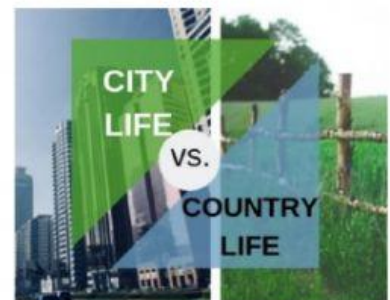

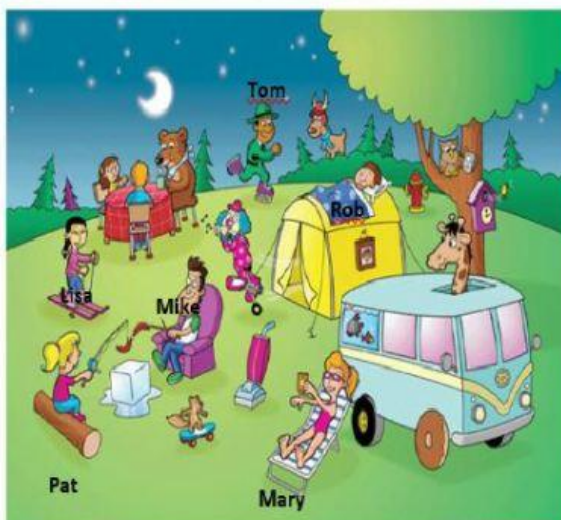
