Unusual Pets



Iguanas are reptiles. They are quite easy to have as pets but they need a large space to live in. It's important to make sure that there is space in your house because iguanas grow up to 1.5 metres. Every day they need food and clean water. The best food for iguanas is vegetables or fruits. Iguanas can bite and scratch, so it's important that you are very careful when you are near them.



Scorpions are arachnids. They are in the same family as spiders! The best scorpions to keep as pets are emperor scorpions. They are one of the biggest scorpions in the world. They can grow up to 20 centimetres long but they are quite easy to look after. The best food for pet scorpions includes crickets, moths and cockroaches! They also need a small bowl of water. You can pick them up, but you need to be very careful - they sting!



Sugar gliders are small marsupials. The longest is 17 centimetres long. They are in the same family as kangaroos. They need a very big cage that has space for some small trees. The best food for sugar gliders includes vegetables, nuts and eggs. They need to eat every day. Sugar gliders are very friendly, but they have got very sharp teeth and claws, so you need to be careful when you hold them.
