Girl: She's got a funny little face!

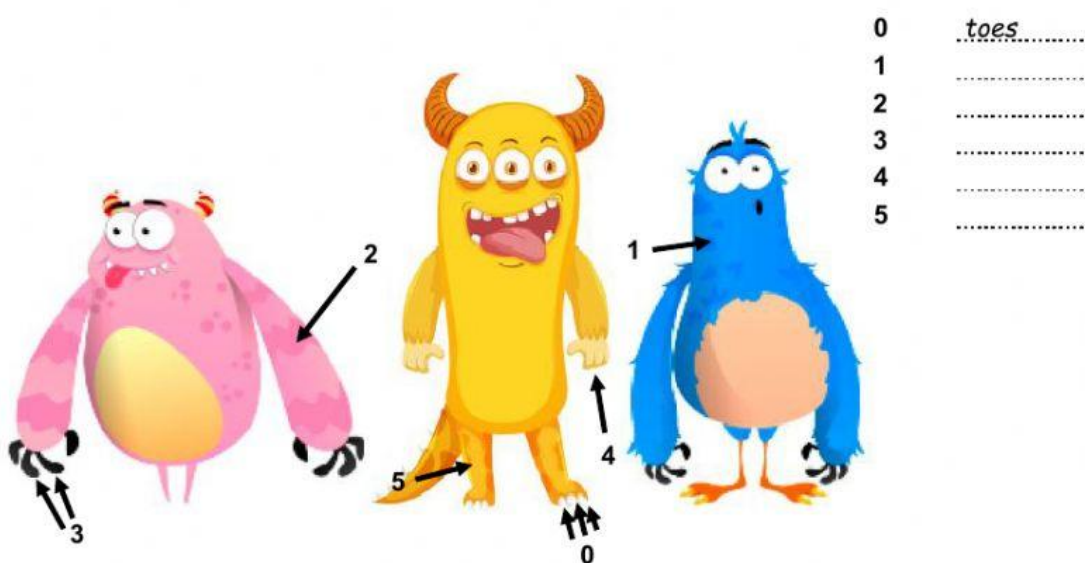
