Type	Modal verb	Examples
Ability	Can (present) Could (past)	David can speak three languages He could speak fluent French when we was 5
Permission	Can / May Could (more polite)	Can I sit in that chair? Could I have some water, please?
Advice	Should	You should go to the dentist once a year
Obligation	Must	You must study every day
Possibility	May Might (more unlikely)	This t-shirt may be very expensive It might rain later
