

Obligation and prohibition with verbs must, have (got) to, needn't

Obligation:

<u>You</u>	<u>must</u>	phone her.
	<u>have to</u>	
	<u>have got to</u>	

No obligation

(lack of obligation):

<u>You</u>	<u>don't have to</u>	phone her now.
	<u>haven't got to</u>	
	<u>needn't</u>	

Prohibition: You mustn't phone her now.

NOTE

Need can also be used as a full verb.

I need (to use) the phone.

I don't need (to use) the phone.

2. We can use three different ways to express a lack of obligation: don't have to,
