

## THE PASSIVE VOICE – DIFFERENT TENSES

### Present simple passive (am/is/are + past participle)

- 1) Uniforms \_\_\_\_\_ (wear) in many British schools.
- 2) In summer, more ice cream \_\_\_\_\_ (eat) than in winter.
- 3) Milk \_\_\_\_\_ (keep) in the fridge.
- 4) Portuguese language \_\_\_\_\_ (speak) in Brazil.
- 5) Today, a lot of cars \_\_\_\_\_ (make) in South Korea.
- 6) Alcohol \_\_\_\_\_ (not sell) to anyone under 18. It's against the law.

### Past simple passive (was/were + past participle)

- 1) The song *Yesterday* \_\_\_\_\_ (compose) in 1965.
- 2) Buckingham Palace \_\_\_\_\_ (build) in 1703.
- 3) The royal wedding \_\_\_\_\_ (watch) by millions of people in 2011.
- 4) The children \_\_\_\_\_ (save) by the firefighters last night.
- 5) My keys \_\_\_\_\_ (find) two days ago.
- 6) Their beds \_\_\_\_\_ (not make) this morning.

### Will future passive (will be + past participle)

- 1) The museum \_\_\_\_\_ (visit) by thousands of people next year.
- 2) The contract \_\_\_\_\_ (sign) by our boss.
- 3) Your order \_\_\_\_\_ (take) by one of the waiters.
- 4) The new book \_\_\_\_\_ (publish) next month.

### Present perfect passive (have been / has been + past participle)

- 1) Many buildings \_\_\_\_\_ (destroy) in the earthquake in Mexico.
- 2) Many lives \_\_\_\_\_ (lose) in the tsunami in Indonesia.
- 3) He \_\_\_\_\_ (employ) by a big computer company.
- 4) Our house \_\_\_\_\_ (break) into.
- 5) Some trees \_\_\_\_\_ (plant) in the street.
- 6) I \_\_\_\_\_ (not bite) by a snake.
