We use:

- a the ¹ *present simple* for something that happens regularly, always or never.
- b the ² for something happening at this moment.
- c the ³ for something happening around this time.
- d the ⁴ for stating a fact.
- e the ⁵ with certain verbs that we do not usually use in continuous tenses: *believe, know, like, love, need, understand, want*, etc.
- f the ⁶ for future arrangements.
