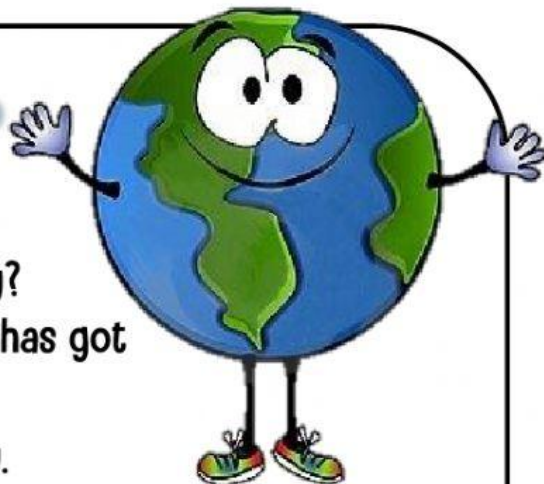


THE BLUE PLANET



Earth is called the blue planet. Do you know why?
From space the Earth looks like blue because it has got a lot of water. Water exists in three states.

- Water can be **SOLID**. Think of ice and snow.
- Water can be **LIQUID**. This is the water we drink.
- Water can also be a **GAS**. We call this vapour or steam.

Every living thing on Earth contains water. An elephant is **70** percent water; a tomato is **90** percent water; mice and people are **65** percent water.
