Present Progressive represents something that is happening at the moment. ie. I am swimming. He is sleeping. Below is how to form the Present Progressive:

Estar + Verb Stem + ANDO/IENDO

AR verbs:

ER/IR verb:

Drop the verb ending and add "ANDO"

I am speaking - Estoy hablando
(hablar)

Drop the ending and add "IENDO"

I am writing - Estoy escribiendo

(escribir)

OTHER RULES:

- If a verb stem ends in a vowel drop the vowel and add a "y" ie: creer - creyendo, leer - leyendo, ir - yendo
- 2. If a verb has an "o" in it, change the "o" to "u"
