Min. of Education pushes back return to in-person learning for public schools

NASSAU, BAHAMAS — Minister of Education Jeffrey Lloyd yesterday confirmed officials will not meet the February 1 target for the return of in-person learning at public schools in the capital and several other islands.

Lloyd said the ministry was still in discussion with health officials over the move during an interview with BNS.

Lloyd said: "Unfortunately, we will not be able to return to in-person learning for the islands of New Providence, Abaco, Exuma, and Eleuthera on the February 1 date that we had targeted because we are still in conversation in discussion with the ministry of health and health officials.

"They have requested of us to outline every specifically which we have the protocols for a variety of circumstances."
