READ THE KEY EXPRESSIONS BELOW:

Key expressions used for predicting and forecasting

Asking for predictions:

- Is... likely to....? (Is the office likely to close?)
- Are ... likely to...? (Are employees likely to quit?)
- Do you think ...will...? (Do you think we will return to the office soon?)
- Do you expect...? (Do you expect to see an increase in productivity?)

Making predictions:

- ... will probably / definitely... (Our employees will probably feel more motivated.)
- ... probably / definitely won't.... (It definitely won't be easy for people.)
- ... is /are (more-less) likely / unlikely to... (The office is unlikely to close completely. /
 "Teleworkers are less likely to get promoted because they are missing face-time with
 their bosses" Adam Grant.)

Expressing hope:

- I hope... will / won't .. (We hope the new scheme will save the company a lot of money.)
- Hopefully... will / won't ... (Hopefully, our teleworkers will have similar results.)
