***Bear** has two past participles **born** and **borne** with difference in meaning.

We use **born** to talk about birth and **borne** for any other thing **not related** to birth.

***Hang** has two past participle forms **hung** and **hanged** that are also its simple past with a change in meaning.

Hung is used when **we are not** talking about someone sentenced by law to die by hanging.

Hanged is used when we are talking about someone who is put to death by hanging.

***Lay** is easily confused, since it's also the simple past tense of Lie (Irregular). Its past participle is the same as its past tense.

***Lie** is another confusing verb. Lie can be irregular or regular with a difference in meaning. In this activity we are focusing on its irregular form.

Lie (Irregular) refers to the horizontal position to sleep whether on a bed or on the floor.
