<p>☺ Some is used with both <u>countable</u> (plural noun พหุจन์) and <u>uncountable nouns</u>:</p> <p>Countable Nouns - 'Some <u>students</u> in my school like doing sport.'</p> <p>Uncountable Nouns - 'There is some <u>dust</u>(ฝุ่น) on the table'</p> <p>☺ Some is used in <u>positive sentences</u> (ประโยคบวก): 'I have <u>some friends</u>.'</p> <p>'There is <u>some coffee</u>.'</p>	<p>☺ Any is used in <u>negative sentences</u>: 'I don't have <u>any friends</u>.' (countable noun)</p> <p>'There isn't <u>any coffee</u>.' (uncountable noun)</p> <p>☺ Any is used in <u>questions</u>: 'Do you have <u>any money</u>?' 'Is there <u>any sugar</u>?'</p> <p>☺ Any is used with both <u>countable</u> (plural noun พหุจน์) and <u>uncountable nouns</u></p>
