Time markers

Key words help us to recognize the future simple tense in a sentence. Below is a list of signal words for the simple future tense:

- I think: WAITER: What will you have for breakfast?
COSTUMER: **I think** I will have a cup of coffee. **Spontaneous Decision: It is decided now, it is not planned**
- probably It will probably rain tomorrow **Prediction**
- Perhaps Perhaps, it will rain tomorrow **Prediction**
(A la major)
- I promise I promise, it won't happen again **For a promise**

Future

When we talk about "future", we think of these time phrases.

- **tomorrow** It will be sunny **tomorrow**
- **soon** We will see you **soon**
- **later** I'll tidy my room **later**
- **next** day/week/month/year
I promise, I will study harder **next week**.
