These verbs are called **regular** because they all add the same ending **-ed** on it.

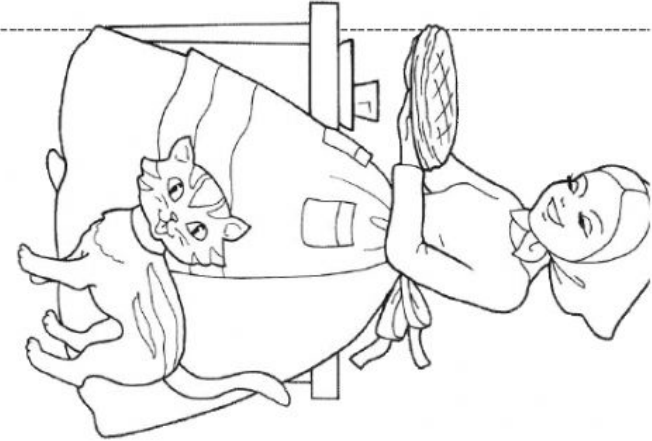
Examples: cook - cooked, play - played, wash - washed,

1. Regular verbs make their Past Tense by adding **-ed**.

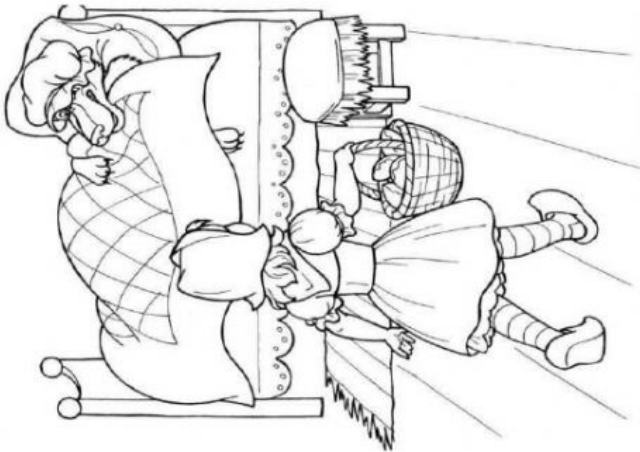

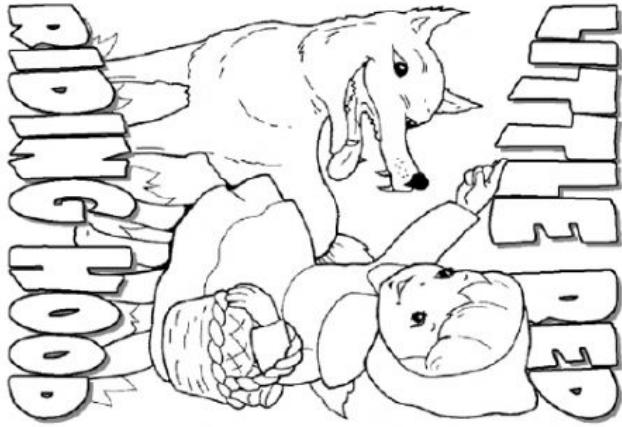

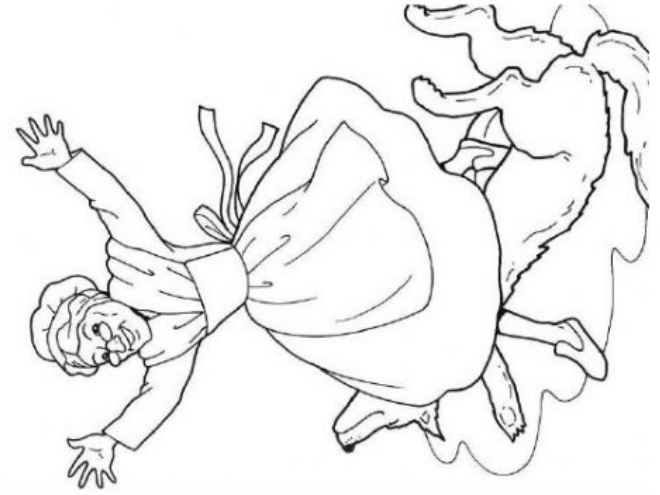
