

Tázací dovětky - minulé časy

- u minulých časů bud' máme pomocné sloveso (was, were, have, has) a v tom případě je to jednodušší a toto pomocné sloveso použijeme i v dovětce:

Př. **It** was written in London, wasn't it?

Jane has been to France, hasn't **she**?

They haven't seen it, have **they**?

- kde pomocné sloveso není a hlavní sloveso má koncovku -ed (nebo tvar, který znáte z nepravidelných sloves), jedná se o minulý čas prostý a zde používáme pomocné sloveso DID/DIDN'T

Př. **You** swam there yesterday, didn't **you**?

She cooked dinner, didn't **she**?

Peter and Jane didn't get married, did **they**?
