→ These are nice sunglasses.
→ Those are cool sandals.

this + a singular verb and:
these + a plural verb to
talk about people, animals
or things that are near.

We use:

that + a singular verb
and: **those** + a plural verb
to talk about people, ani-
mals or things that are far.
