Verbs- The Simple Present Tense- This tells that an action is being performed at the present time. It is also used for habitual actions, facts and permanent situations.

Verbs in the present tense have two forms:

The singular form ends with an –s. Example: likes

Note that with the pronouns I and you there is no –s. Example: like

The plural form does not end with –s. Example: like
