

## PRESENT PERFECT AFFIRMATIVE EXERCISES WITH REGULAR VERBS

REMEMBER!! PRESENT PERFECT IS FORMED BY THE VERB TO HAVE+ THE PAST PARTICIPLE OF THE VERB.

REGULAR VERBS FORM THE PAST PARTICIPLE ADDING -ED TO THE INFINITIVE.

EXAMPLE:

WORK - ( I, YOU, WE, THEY) HAVE / (HE, SHE, IT) HAS WORKED

CHANGE - ( I, YOU, WE, THEY) HAVE / (HE, SHE, IT) HAS  
CHANGED
