Singular (One person/thing)	Conjugate your verb ending for Singular Form	Plural (more than one person/thing)	Conjugate your verb ending for Singular Form
<u>Yo</u> – I (you are doing the action by yourself.)		<u>Nosotros/Nosotras</u> – We (bc "I" am included in this group)	
<u>Tú</u> – You (informal – how you speak to someone that you know = <u>DIRECTLY</u> to them alone)		<u>Vosotros/Vosotras</u> – You all (informal - group of <u>FRIENDS</u> you are speaking to <u>DIRECTLY</u>)	
<u>Usted</u> – You (formal – how you speak to an adult <u>DIRECTLY</u> w/respect)		<u>Ustedes</u> – You all (formal – group of <u>ADULTS</u> you are speaking to <u>DIRECTLY</u> with respect)	
<u>Él</u> – He (speaking about he/him to someone else)		<u>Ellos</u> – They (talking <u>ABOUT</u> a group of all guys/guys & girls to someone else)	
<u>Ella</u> – She (speaking about she/her to someone else)		<u>Ellas</u> – They (talking <u>ABOUT</u> a group of all girls to someone else)
