Singular (One person/thing)	Conjugate your verb ending for Singular Form	Plural (more than one person/thing)	Conjugate your verb ending for Singular Form
Yo – I (you are doing the action by yourself.)		Nosotros/Nosotras – We (bc "I" am included in this group)	
Tú – You (informal – how you speak to someone that you know = <u>DIRECTLY</u> to them alone)		Vosotros/Vosotras – You all (informal - group of <u>FRIENDS</u> you are speaking to <u>DIRECTLY</u>)	
Usted – You (formal – how you speak to an adult <u>DIRECTLY</u> w/respect)		Ustedes – You all (formal – group of <u>ADULTS</u> you are speaking to <u>DIRECTLY</u> with respect)	
Él – He (speaking about he/him to someone else)		Ellos – They (talking <u>ABOUT</u> a group of all guys/guys & girls to someone else)	
Ella – She (speaking about she/her to someone else)		Ellas – They (talking <u>ABOUT</u> a group of all girls to someone else)
