TENSE	EXAMPLE	USE
1.Present Simple	<i>It will be all right</i>	Plan (intention)
2.Present Continuous	<i>We'd been trying to get it started</i>	Predicted to have happened by a future time
3.Past Simple	<i>The plant had grown a foot in our absence</i>	Continuous action up to a future time
4.Past Continuous	<i>They'll have been talking for ten hours</i>	Prediction of simultaneous events/happening as a matter of course
5.Future Simple	<i>I was just looking at it</i>	Prediction of completed event
6.Future Continuous	<i>You just never listen, do you?</i>	Continuous before main past reference
7.'going to'future	<i>Neil stepped down</i>	Regular/habitual event, fact
8.Present Perfect Simple	<i>Bill will be seeing his secretary on Monday</i>	Recent event or life experience
9.Present Perfect Continuous	<i>How long have you been telling that joke?</i>	Happening now (temporary)
10.Past Perfect Simple	<i>That's torn it</i>	Completed event before main past reference
11.Past Perfect Continuous	<i>She's standing by the wall</i>	Background past event
12.Future Perfect Simple	<i>They will have destroyed half the rainforests by 2020</i>	Continuous up to now
13.Future Perfect Continuous	<i>You're not going to watch Star Wars again, are you?</i>	Completed past event
