- Used to authenticate official documents
- Created in 1836
- The Live Oak branches represent strength
- The olive branches represent peace
- This is the front side of the seal that we are used to seeing

State Seal of Texas

- The reverse side of the seal was created in 1961
- It is used as a decorative symbol
- The six flags represent the national flags that flew over Texas
- The Alamo is in the top of shield
- The cannon from the Battle of Gonzales and the bridge from the Battle at San Jacinto are at the bottom
