


# Conditionals

**Type 0:** If/When + Present Simple → Present Simple

When you **heat** ice, it **melts**. \*General truths/Laws of Nature



**Type 1:** If + Present Simple → Future Simple/Imperative/Modals+bare infinitive

If you **study**, you **will pass**. \*Sth likely to happen in the future



**Type 2:** If + Past Simple → would + bare infinitive

If I **were** rich, I **would buy** a Ferrari. \*Unreal Present

If I **were** you, I'd talk to him. \* To Give Advice



**Type 3:** If + Past Perfect → would have + past participle

If you **hadn't slept**, you **wouldn't have missed** the bus. \*Unreal Past
