

### 1. Definition:

\_\_\_\_\_ means relating to what must happen because of a law or rule

### Part of speech:

Adjective

### Examples:

- the government have agreed to raise the \_\_\_\_\_ minimum wage
- we get four weeks' \_\_\_\_\_ holiday a year

### 2. Definition:

someone's \_\_\_\_\_ is the fact of their being removed from their job

### Part of speech:

Noun

### Examples:

- he won compensation for unfair \_\_\_\_\_
- his such an offence would justify instant \_\_\_\_\_
- unfair \_\_\_\_\_ constructive \_\_\_\_\_

### 3. Definition:

a \_\_\_\_\_ is a place where very young children are looked after while their parents are at work

### Part of speech:

Noun

### Examples:

- we have a \_\_\_\_\_ at work where I can leave my daughter
- the \_\_\_\_\_ opens at 8 in the morning

### 4. Definition:

a \_\_\_\_\_ is something that you get for free from your employer, for example free or cheap food, a car, or medical insurance

### Part of speech:

Noun

### Examples:

- we all get subsidised travel, which is a nice \_\_\_\_\_
- the company's employees enjoy a number of \_\_\_\_\_

### 5. Definition:

\_\_\_\_\_ of the workforce is when an employer doesn't use so many permanent staff and employs workers on short-term contracts

## **Part of speech:**

Noun uncount

## **Examples:**

- Even with all this outsourcing and \_\_\_\_\_, there are still 300,000 workers employed in the industry.
- employers were accused of having secret \_\_\_\_\_ plans

## **6. Definition:**

\_\_\_\_\_ is time off work that someone gets when a close relative is seriously ill or has died

## **Part of speech:**

Noun uncount

## **Examples:**

- he was allowed home from the army on \_\_\_\_\_
- when he returned from \_\_\_\_\_ he found that everything had changed

## **7. Definition:**

if you \_\_\_\_\_ someone who has died, you feel sad that they are dead and behave quietly and respectfully for a while

## **Part of speech:**

Verb

## **Examples:**

- she was widely \_\_\_\_\_ throughout Japan
- following his death in 1965, the whole nation \_\_\_\_\_
- the community \_\_\_\_\_ the loss of one its most popular characters

## **Collocates:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ someone's death
- \_\_\_\_\_ for someone

## **8. Definition:**

if you \_\_\_\_\_ something, you say that you strongly disapprove of it and think it is bad or morally wrong

## **Part of speech:**

Verb

## **Examples:**

- politicians from all sides \_\_\_\_\_ the violence
- the killings were strongly \_\_\_\_\_ by the church

### 9. Definition:

if someone in authority \_\_\_\_\_ someone something, they give it to them or allow them to have it

### Part of speech:

Verb

### Examples:

- the local council have \_\_\_\_\_ permission for the building to be demolished
- the judge \_\_\_\_\_ her a divorce on the grounds of her husband's unreasonable behaviour

### Collocates:

- \_\_\_\_\_ permission
- \_\_\_\_\_ a request

### 10. Definition:

\_\_\_\_\_ is regular failure to be at work or at school

### Part of speech:

Noun uncount

### Examples:

- we've launched a crackdown on \_\_\_\_\_
- we have a happy workforce with low rates of \_\_\_\_\_

### 11. Definition:

\_\_\_\_\_ is hard physical work

### Part of speech:

Noun uncount

### Examples:

- the new machinery will save a lot of time and \_\_\_\_\_
- he came home tired out by the \_\_\_\_\_ of building a wall

### 12. Definition:

\_\_\_\_\_ is paper, pens, envelopes and other things that are used for writing

### Part of speech:

Noun uncount

### Examples:

- lots of people take \_\_\_\_\_ home from work
- you'll find everything you need in the \_\_\_\_\_ cupboard
- I just need some basic office \_\_\_\_\_

### **13. Definition:**

a \_\_\_\_\_ is a kind of court that has authority to make decisions about particular problems

### **Part of speech:**

Noun

### **Examples:**

- an employment \_\_\_\_\_
- the \_\_\_\_\_ ruled that he had been unfairly dismissed
- he took his case to an industrial \_\_\_\_\_ (one that deals with employment rights)

### **Collocates:**

- employment/industrial/military \_\_\_\_\_
