



- **ADVISE (verb) – ADVICE (a piece of.../some)**

(take my advice/follow my advice/give sb advice/get advice from sb)

I advise you **to revise** this vocabulary

I advise **your revising** this vocabulary

- **RECOMMEND/PROPOSE /SUGGEST/URGE**

I recommend/propose/urge/suggest **(your) revising**

I recommend/suggest/urge/suggest **(that) you (should) revise**
(infinitive)

EXAMPLES

► I advise **you to be** there early

► I recommend /suggest **you be** there early

► I suggest **that George go**

► I suggest **George going**

► I suggest **George's going**
