| | This is a smaller river that flows into a bigger river. |
| | This is when the river gets larger. It has more water and flows more slowly in a flat area. |
| | This is where the river starts. |
| | This is where a river meets the sea or ocean. |
| | This is fresh water that filters through the ground. |
| | This is a large area of fresh water surrounded by land. It is a natural deposit of water. |
| | This is smaller than a lake. |
| | This is a large, flowing body of fresh water. |
| | This is the last part of the river, when it approaches the sea. |
