A SHORT HISTORY OF THE FLAG

The Union Flag, also known as the Union Jack, is the national flag of the UK. The first version of the flag is dated back to 1606. 8.1. But it looked a bit different from what we have today. 8.2. Now, the flag consists of three heraldic crosses: the cross of St. George (which represents England), the cross saltire of St. Andrew (representing Scotland), and the cross saltire of St. Patrick (which represents Ireland). 8.3. However, the Union Jack would look extraordinary with a dragon. Today, 23 countries feature the Union Flag. 8.4. If you see the Union Flag above Buckingham Palace, Windsor Castle and Sandringham, you can be sure the Queen is not there.
