Sir Paul McCartney



1.

Sir James Paul McCartney **was born** on June 18, 1942 in Liverpool, England. He is a singer-songwriter and composer who was part of one of the greatest bands of all time – The Beatles.

2.

McCartney is **listed** in the Guinness World Records as the "most successful musician and composer in popular music history", with 60 gold discs and sales of 100 million singles in the United Kingdom.

3.

Sir James Paul McCartney was born in Walton Hospital to Mary Patricia McCartney, a nurse and James (Jim) McCartney, a *cotton* salesman. He also has a brother, Micheal.

At age 15, McCartney **met** John Lennon and his band "The Quarrymen" which eventually **turned** into "The Beatles" in 1960. George Harrison **joined** the group in 1958.

4.

The Beatles **became** one of the most commercially successful bands in the history of pop music. The group's line up **consisted of** John Lennon (rhythm guitar, vocals), Paul McCartney (bass guitar, vocals), George Harrison (lead guitar, vocals) and Ringo Starr (drums, vocals).

Their popularity **led** to a musical revolution called "Beatlemania".

5.

After the band **separated**, McCartney **continued** with a successful solo career and also **formed** the band Wings with his then wife, Linda Eastman, and singer-songwriter Denny Laine.

6.

Apart from his work in music, McCartney is also an *advocate* for animal rights, for vegetarianism, and for music education. He is a football fan of Everton and Liverpool football clubs.
