"Good morning, Cooking Stars! Let's cook!" said Hugo.

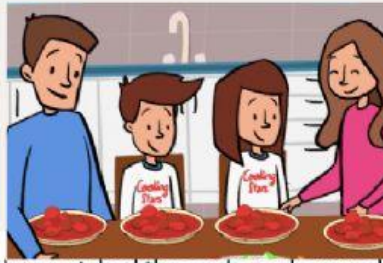
"Yes, let's do that right now!" said Anna.
