PART 1:

1. Millions of tourists (travel) to Paris every year.
2. My father (play) tennis twice a week.
3. My brother (not/sleep) right now. He (check) his e-mails.
4. People sometimes (fall) when they go skiing for the first time.
5. John lives in Vancouver, but he (visit) his brother right now in Chicago.
6. Every Friday afternoon, my friend and I (eat) lunch together.
7. Mr. Wallace (talk) with a customer at the moment.
8. My sister (not/eat) meat. I (not/eat) it either. We are vegetarians.

PART 2:

1. I (brush) my teeth every morning and night. My brother also (brush) his teeth.
2. Right now, my brother (do) his homework. He (go) to university, so he usually (have) a lot of homework.
3. My sister is at home too. She (not/do) homework. She (watch) TV. She always (watch) TV at night. She (work) every day, so after work, she (feel) tired. She (relax) when she watches TV.
