Interrogative				Short answers		
Am	I	going to	go hiking? play tennis?	Yes,	I	am.
Are	you / we / they				you / we / they	are.
					she / he	is.
Is	she / he			No,	I	'm not.
					you / we / they	aren't.
					she / he	isn't.

When we want to ask about future plans, we form the question by inverting the order: we use the appropriate form of the verb *to be* first, and then the subject.
