


Silent Letters



The English language has a lot of words with silent letters.

A silent letter is a letter that you don't hear or pronounce when some words are spoken.

Examples:

- island
- answer
- would



Some words are tricky to pronounce because their silent letters make their pronunciation different from their spelling.

scene = /sɪn/

would = /wʊd/



Let's check some examples of silent letters.

Silent b:

- bomb
- climb
- thumb

As in:

- I hurt my thumb.

Silent c:

- descend
- scene
- scientist

As in:

- Scientists discovered a new chemical element.



Silent e:

- distance
- commerce
- love

As in:

- Kids love learning about ancient history.

Silent g:

- champagne
- resign
- design

As in:

- The seat belt is a device designed to keep passengers safe in a vehicle.



Silent gh:

- high
- throughout

As in:

- Throughout history, man has found inspiration in nature.

Silent k:

- knew
- knife

As in:

- Native Americans used stones or bones for the knife blade.



Silent l:

- calm
- could

As in:

- Before the wheel, traders couldn't transport goods easily.

Silent t:

- listen
- whistle

As in:

- Referees first used whistles in football matches in England in 1878.



Silent s:

- debris
- aisle
- island

As in:

- Greenland is the world's biggest island.

Silent u:

- guilt
- tongue
- guitar

As in:

- The electric guitar is one of the most popular inventions in the 20th century.



Silent w:

- write
- wrong
- answer
- sword
- wrist

As in:

- The first wristwatch was introduced in the 16th century.
