Definitions:

- a. : to live or manage without something that is usually considered necessary or desirable
- b. : to continue doing something, especially after a pause or interruption, or to have a good relationship with someone
- c. : to proceed with or undertake a task or activity in a particular way, often involving a series of steps or actions
- d. : to tolerate or endure something unpleasant or difficult, often over a long period of time
- e. : to complete or perform a task or activity that has been planned or requested
- f. : to gradually develop or increase something, such as strength, confidence, or a collection of things
- g. : to do something, often something mischievous or secretive, that others may disapprove of or be unaware of
- h. : to eventually reach or find oneself in a particular situation, often unexpectedly or unintentionally
