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We use	
Will	Going to
To express predictions in the future	To express plans
To make promises or express personal opinions (I promise, I think...)	To express predictions based on present evidence
To make at-the-moment decisions (immediate decisions)	
Examples	
Person + will /won't + verb (infinitive without to)	Person + verb to be (am, is ,are) + going to+ verb (infinitive without to)
Andy will be an important artist. He is very talented!	Andrea is going to play the guitar at the party. She is practicing now.
