The latest issue of *Sinh vien online* published the findings of a study by Dr. Le Van Lan, an English Language lecturer, that have drawn upon a lot of attention.

The study was carried out 2 months ago and it (1).....to analyze the effects of romantic relationships on university students. However, unlike what most people think, the (2).....of the study isn't to (3).....how university students' studying results are affected. A survey with 5 questions was used with the (6)..... to collect opinions from 2000 university freshmen in Vietnam. The results were really interesting.

This statistics (8).....a surprising trend to most parents, who usually think their 18-19-year-old children are little babies to them. Also surprisingly, more than half of the students believe that spending money for a romantic relationship does affect their financial situations when they start falling in love, but later on, it doesn't. The (9)..... additionally indicates that 64% of the students asked use the money they earn from a part-time job for their lover. This evidence (10).....to light the fact that parents' worry about their children's wasting their money on a boyfriend or a girlfriend is useless.

The last two questions in the survey seek to analyze how their financial situations affect students' romantic relationship and whether the relation can last. It is good to know that students have quite realistic view of money, with 60% believe that love exists without being affected by love, and 55% agree that how long love exists doesn't depend on how much money they have.
