**Short forms**

I don't like playing

it doesn't like playing  
we don't like playing  
you don't like playing  
they don't like playing



don't = do not

doesn't = does not

We use the present simple of like + -ing form to talk about things that we enjoy doing or don't enjoy doing.

*I like reading comics. She doesn't like playing chess.*


